

Winterfield Twp. Planning/Zoning Commission Meeting
August 14, 2018

Meeting Called to Order 7:03pm. Pledge of Allegiance given. Roll Call: Present, S. Land, S. Laughlin, J. Traynor. Absent, M. Prielipp, A. Laughlin and Zoning Adm. M. Clark. Minutes of the June 12, 2018 meeting read and approved. Motion by Land, 2nd by S. Laughlin. Passed.

Old Business: Discussion regarding the recent mix-up on the brining of gravel roads. Beckman is doing brining. There was a mix-up on agreement of price. Board of Trustees held a special meeting to settle matter and signed an edited contract. Brining now costs more.
