March 10, 2020: Presidential Primary Polls are open from 7 am until 8 pm

March 9, 2020, 4 pm: Last chance to vote by AV ballot at the Township Clerk's Office

March 7, 2020, 10 am until 6 pm: Township Clerk available for absentee ballots

March 3, 2020, 10 am: Public Accuracy Test will be held at Winterfield Township Hall, 8987 Cook Avenue, Marion, MI 49665. The Public Accuracy Test is conducted to demonstrate that the program and computer that will be used to tabulate the results of the election counts the votes in the manner prescribed by law. All are invited to attend.
