August 1, 2 pm: Last opportunity to submit written request to spoil your absent voter ballot and receive a new one by mail

August 3, 4 pm: Deadline to vote an absentee ballot or spoil your ballot in the clerk's office

Changes in Election Law: Due to Proposal 3 of November 2018 anyone who is registered to vote can request an absentee ballot for any election. If you are on the Permanent AV List, you will receive an application for every election and may choose whether or not to vote by absentee ballot or in person.
