The minutes of the regular meeting, of the Board of Trustees, of July 14, 2015 held at the Winterfield Township Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Hammar at 7:00 p.m. All rose to recite the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken all Board members were present, except for our vacationing Treasurer. Also present were Karen Lipovsky, Corey Barz (from Clare County Transit) and Carl Traynor.

Agenda was accepted as adjusted. Motioned by Shelly and seconded by Linda.

The minutes of the May 4th meeting were discussed and approved as written. Motioned by Shelly and seconded by Harry.

Karen Lipovsky spoke first. Don David was Chair when we bought the boilers. The note on the roof is paid off. All departments handed in their budgets for next year. They totaled \$12 million. They have to be told to cut them down. The Sheriff wants more money, because he has more responsibilities. Veterans Administrator is still selling bricks for Veterans at \$100 and \$200. The land auction is August 14<sup>th</sup>, noon at Dougherty Hotel. All Townships can make their own regulations for golf carts. We got new desks for 911. Mark asked about the 911 call that was made about 3 weeks ago. The Fire Department did not show up for an hour.

Carl Barz spoke next. The Transit building is near the airport in Harrison. You can get a bus here that takes you to another bus, to go to Midland, Mecosta, and Osceola. You can go to Clare or Harrison to go grocery shopping or Dr.'s appointments. They pick up children from school for the sparks program and take them home. They request a 24 hour advance call. One way costs \$3.00, anywhere in the County, 60 or 62 yrs and older costs \$1.00 a ride, each way.

No Zoning Administrator report. Dorwin is ill.

Public Comment - Carl Traynor asked about allowing people to climb in and out of the dumpsters. We discussed many things that are of concern. We decided to hold off on any new rule that would prevent people from recycling metals out of the bins.

Mark stated that he needs workers for the next tire recycling day. He talked about the Quilt Trail. We are paying \$50 to get started on a Quilt Block for the Township Hall. Kathryn needs to make a check for Shelly to send in the application to the Clare County Arts Council.

Mark asked for a motion to pay bills. Harry motioned, Shelly seconded, Bills paid.

There was a motion to adjourn it was accepted all around.
