

Winterfield Twp Planning Commission Meeting
February 9, 2016

Present: Chair Laughlin, Land, F. Prielipp, M. Prielipp, Traynor.
Meeting called to order at 7pm. Pledge of Allegiance was given. Minutes of the December 8, 2015, meeting were read and approved. Motion by Land, 2nd by M. Prielipp.

Old Business: The Winterfield quilt block has been placed on the township hall and positive comments have been made.

New Business: 5 building permits have been issued since May. They went to R. Sutton, R. Miranski, R. Treveso, Recker and S. Pifer. This Board will request copies of permits for this board for review in the future. Laughlin will request current Plat Books for this Board.

K. Mayfield, Clare Co. Clerk, spoke to BOT meeting regarding public officials speaking of propositions which will appear on ballots school ele in upcoming elections and not being able to talk about them 60 days before election. That proposal is now on hold. SB 571.

There will be a school election held in May and voters in this township will vote at this hall.

There was discussion on yard beautification at the Hall and the possibilities of a pavilion and picnic tables.

Also discussion regarding the ISP and the areas that it serves, not directed at the entire township.

The cemetery is in need of a new sign at entrance and driveway stone.

The Road Commission will address the issues with Clareola this year and do some resurfacing. Cook Ave will receive an ultra thin coating next year.

Pine Rd to the east will be addressed as will a better egress to Cranberry Lake.

Land commented that there seems to be poor timing on the application of brine in the summer months.

There is no Public Comment.
